3. MESSAGE FROM THE PRESSURE CISCOMANI TEAM

KEEP THE PRESSURE ON! We have attached **two flyers**, one brand new and one updated, for you to print, share, and distribute in your neighborhood. Make people aware that Ciscomani is not to be trusted; he is in Trump's pocket.

In addition, we have attached **a script** for you to use to contact Ciscomani, to let him know how we feel about tax cuts for the wealthy blowing up the deficit, while cutting benefits for those who need them.

1. Email to submit to Juan Ciscomani's office. Finish it with your name and add ITAA - Indivisible Tucson Action Alliance to the signature block.
2. Call and leave a phone message but change it up a bit to put it in your own voice.

We are asking everyone on the ITAA email list to at least send the email next week, by Wed June 11 at latest. Imagine the impact for Ciscomani to receive 1,500 + messages on the week before he is back in Arizona on break. It will give him something to think about.
