What a wonderful warm joyful gathering!! Indivisibles from all over town gathered to share fellowship and information. No Kings Oct. 18 was entirely peaceful (despite predictions of "blood in the streets" from the regime). This did not happen by accident! **The largest peaceful protest in American history was peaceful because of rigor in planning and discipline in execution**, and because the best people in the country showed up in defense of their first amendment rights. The amount of planning and work it took to make sure that there were tens of thousands of **safety volunteers** in the streets, and to make sure that every one of the 2,700 events had a **safety plan** and a **safety lead** -- that's what got the job done.

WHY ICE AND IMMIGRATION ARE SO IMPORTANT

Ezra: ICE is not a normal government agency or government department. This is America's Gestapo. This is America's secret police force that is terrorizing our communities. **We must not normalize ICE. There must be consequences for those businesses and politicians that enable ICE**, that don't push back. That's why it is crucial to target businesses [like Spotify] that are supporting ICE.

Leah: **The road to authoritarianism in America runs through attacks on immigrants.** When you look at the ways in which they are attempting to consolidate authoritarian power, they are using immigration as the place where they try out and perfect powers that they will eventually use on all of us:

- * detentions without due process (no warrant, no charges, keep moving you so your lawyer doesn't know where you are).
- * detaining people for simply exercising free speech.
- * using military forces for domestic purposes.
- * the expansion of the surveillance state (Flock cameras).

All of this is being piloted in the context of immigration, in order to have that infrastructure for the broader suppression agenda in this country. There is not a "immigration problem" over here and a "democracy" problem over there -- they are one and the same problem.

WHY DEMONSTRATE? In answer to a question of what do you say to people who say that demonstrations don't accomplish anything substantive, here's what Leah had to say:

=> No Kings protests alert the pillars of authoritarianism that they must take into account the forces of resistance.

We don't protest for the sake of protest. It's linked to a strategic logic, which is this: No Kings mass demonstrations show potential regime collaborators that Trump triumphing is NOT inevitable. No Kings communicates to leaders in media, corporations, higher education, law firms, politicians in state and local

governments, leaders who tend to go along with the regime to secure their safety, position, business -- and it shows them that "Oh! There might be this other force in society that is getting bigger and more organized every day that I also have to factor into my calculations as I make decisions!" Stakeholders in society might start to make different decisions based on how much pushback they see, based on how much defiance is in the air. And that's part of what No Kings catalyzes. So that's the first piece, just kind of holding open the space for broader social pushback.

=> No Kings protests creates a sense of a shared movement that helps protestors see that they are a part of something larger than themselves -- and this empowers them.

"Creating a sense of a shared movement identity, amongst a really broad set of people, who are pro-democracy folks. . . . It was an experience for them that made them part of something bigger; that gave them a little bit more hope. That has unpredictable second-order consequences. Because in this moment, we need people to do so many things, and we can't put them all into one campaign and say "Do this one action."

* We need people to go to their PTA meeting and say, "What is this school's plan to protect kids from ICE?" and if there isn't a plan, say, "Hey, I'm going to get a bunch of parents together who will show up at this school if ICE comes, and we're all going to be organizing that."

* We need people to go to their faith community, their house of worship, and say to their minister or rabbi, "Why are you not talking about how these cuts are going to affect people in our communities? Why are you not sharing that with our community?"

* We need people to say, "I'm not going to follow that order at work that is illegal." All of those things require people feeling like they are part of a bigger movement, and that is what No Kings catalyzes."

=> No Kings protests are recruitment events that allow us to build capacity and put it to work.

People who are new to marches are getting activated for the first time, and they are joining groups and even founding new groups. These demonstrations help create the cadre of folks across the country who are organizing for mutual aid, for

immigrant support, for the political, electoral, and civic engagement and advocacy that we are going to need to do in the future.

This week we are prioritizing pressuring Ciscomani to engage the House of Representatives to restore the health care cuts and end the government shutdown, as well as to continue pressure to get Adelita seated in Congress.

A. HEALTH CARE OR SHUTDOWN – This is such a critical and timely issue that we are asking membership to continue call for an end to this politically motivated shutdown.

*“That budget reconciliation law, which Republicans call the One Big Beautiful Bill Act or Working Families Tax Cut Act, allows the **enhanced premium tax credits** that made ACA coverage more affordable for households between 100% and 400% of the federal poverty level to **LAPSE at the end of this year.**”*

NOTICES OF PREMIUM INCREASES ARE BEING RECEIVED NOW, AND MAY GO INTO EFFECT AS EARLY AS NOVEMBER 1.

Democrats are fighting back to restore these cuts as part of their agreeing to vote for a continuing resolution to reopen the government open.

2. Gallego and Kelly: Hold the Line to Restore Medicaid and Health Insurance Premium Subsidies to Keep the Government Open

Democrats have more clout in the Senate because the Continuing Resolution requires 609 votes to avoid a filibuster. Our Senators have been holding firm, but your support will mean a lot to them:

B. SEAT ADELITA NOW!

While Ciscomani has stated that he believes that she should be sworn in, he blames Democrats for the government shutdown. There is no reason why she could not be sworn in during one of the brief "Pro Forma" sessions that the House continues to have even during shutdown mode. In fact, three Republican members have been seated the day after their special elections, but Adelita Grijalva has been denied taking her seat to represent the 800,000+ Arizonans who have been without representation since her father Raul passed away in August of 2025.

All indications point to Speaker Johnson withholding her swearing in AND sending the House out of Washington on an unscheduled break is to use her seat as leverage to force Democrats to concede on the critical issues they are holding firm on including saving the Affordable Care Act premium subsidies.

In addition, seating Adelita will provide the final signature needed to issue the

Epstein Files Release act. The Speaker and White house are doing everything possible to avoid the blowback if and when the full files are released.

Beyond the crass political games going on in DC, this is a basic question of fairness. While Juan Ciscomani projects an image of a straight shooter / man of the people, his actions and inactions in Congress speak otherwise.

There were already plenty of reasons to boycott Spotify, but the latest calls come after Spotify refused to remove government sponsored, tax-payer funded recruitment ads for ICE. Who doesn't love a good meal out occasionally? It can be a nice way to enjoy getting to know Tucson with friends, family or maybe even meet some great new people. And this week Barbara Rose shares her experience of on great option here in town: [Midtown Vegan Deli](#). Think how much better your meal will be knowing the business you are giving your money to supports our immigrant community with signs of solidarity and seeks to provide a safe and welcome space for all.

Thanks to Barbara Rose for helping whet our taste buds and inspire our conscious shopper mindset with her story below:

A visit to one of Tucson's better kept secrets today has me wanting to share with others about this deli located at Rosemont and 5th Street on the grounds of the

previous deli which was a staple in the area for years. But this one, Midtown Vegan Deli and Market, owned by Tanya Barnett has as its motto 'Local vibes with a Twist.' The twist is probably its very welcoming atmosphere where you can sit in quiet surroundings for as long as suits while eating off their totally vegan menu.

This deli offers Breakfast All Day and has shakes and smoothies galore. One of the favorite items, The Hot Reuben Sandwich, has no animals involved but you would never know. French Dip, BLT and Tuna Melt all find new iterations that are tasty and timeless. Tacos, burritos, even a Sonoran Dog are all reasonably priced. At the counter are bakery and desert items. As part of the store, both refrigerated items and freezer offerings like pizza are available. Additional food items fill shelves along the opposite wall. Atop that selection is a variety of tee shirts for sale emblazoned with sayings like "Let's Be Better Humans" and "Resist: Go Vegan". A large quote from Jane Goodall reminds that "You cannot go through a single day without having an impact on the world around you."

On the website for the business is a clear explanation of what this great place is about. "Here at Midtown Vegan Deli our goal is to help save the animals and the planet one delicious meal at a time. We care about all living beings and provide a safe, welcome space for all. We don't judge, we encourage. We believe that everyone can do better and be better and we hope that our little deli will inspire you to make that journey."

A chat with the owner was a wonderful reminder that even when we don't know it we are connected. Tanya is one of my daughter's oldest Tucson friends and is so happy we are featuring her establishment. In June I had offered giving a farewell party to a dear friend relocating to France. Her only request was that the caterer be Midtown Vegan Deli and it was my delight to make that happen. All the guests (vegan or non) were delighted by the food at that event. From my perspective the staff were very helpful in determining the menu and were very accommodating and easy to work with. Whatever your desire --deli, cafe, market or catering – all are found at Midtown Vegan Deli.
