Monday, Sept. 1, 2025, 4:00 P.M.

Approximately 70 members attending on Zoom

Margrit McIntosh: Host

- Welcomed everyone
- Provided an overview of today's agenda featuring our guest speakers and team reports.

Tina Whitley: Co-host

- Thanked everyone for coming on the Labor Day holiday
- Noted that 400-500 people showed up for the Labor Day march, rally and picnic that was held in support of our labor groups and unions.

Guest speaker: Francesca Martin, co-founder and deputy director of Keep Arizona Blue

- Keep Arizona Blue was formed 5 years ago to engage students and get them to vote.
- They focused on voter registration, round table discussions, canvassing, phone banking, texting, social media posts, community events and candidate workshops.
- They are willing to provide a Youth Engagement Plan for any candidate who requests one.
- 7,000 young people have connected with them; their interns receive college credit
- In the last election they sent out 18,000 postcards, 677,267 texts, canvassed 10,000 doors
- We need your help to counter the GOP Turning Point's messaging to young voters, especially young women.

Guest speaker: Bennett Burke, Democray Unites Us Town Criers

- Pastor Burke's group Matthew 25:34 has been feeding the unhoused for years and participated in marches and protests. <https://www.facebook.com/Matthew2534CG>
- With so many people tuning out the news, something more is required and that's where Town Criers comes in: a small group of people popping up in unexpected places with a 1-minute powerful message
- Their first flash mob will expose Marriot hotels for breaking their promise to NOT work with ICE on their properties, urging a boycott of Marriot and publicizing ICE's actions.

- Their first Town Crier team of 20–23-year-olds may encourage other young people to step up and get involved.
- Pastor Burke noted there’s nothing illegal about being annoying and more volunteers are needed.
- The first Town Criers action, at the “Aloft” hotel in Tucson at Speedway and Campbell (a Marriott property), will be on Sept. 12 at 6 p.m.
- They are also looking at an ICE vigil at Country Club and Valencia.
- The Town Criers need: tech skills, a website, a video editor, a social media influencer.
- Their #1 ask is for Troup Leaders to form groups of 5-10 people.

Ken Minkoff, Pressure Ciscomani Team

- 40 people are on their email list and are being asked every week to submit specific ideas on how to unseat Ciscomani
- CD6 is one of the tightest, most flippable districts in the country, and is getting a ton of national attention.
- The team is distributing flyers in neighbors, creating bumper stickers, researching Ciscomani’s votes, actions, and social media posts
- They have attracted national attention and are working with Honest Arizona, Worker Power, Keep Arizona Blue along with other groups.

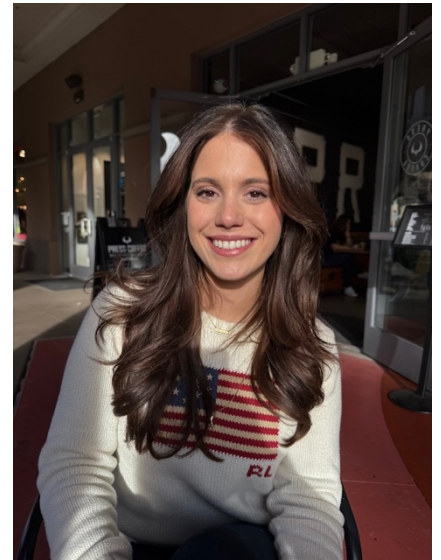

APPENDIX: Bios of our speakers

Francesca Martin <francesca@keepazblue.org>

Francesca Martin is a Political Science student at Arizona State University. Raised in a proud union home, she developed a deep understanding of how elections and policies shape people’s lives. Her political involvement began with Students for Biden-Harris 2020, where she worked alongside fellow students to help elect Joe Biden.



Recognizing the need for stronger youth engagement in local elections, she co-founded Keep Arizona Blue Student Coalition and now serves as its deputy director. The organization is dedicated to expanding the youth electorate across Arizona and cultivating the next generation of campaign leaders.

She has worked on local campaigns across the state of Arizona from the school district, city, and county level to help candidates and campaigns win their elections. In 2024,

Francesca was honored with the Arizona Democratic Party Hall of Fame award for her commitment to empowering communities within the Democratic Party. She remains passionate about driving meaningful change and advancing values that positively impact people's lives.

Bennett Burke, Executive Committee Member of Democracy Unites Us

Bennett Burke was the originator of the concept for June 14th's "No Kings Day Motor March." Prior to joining DUU, Bennett was an organizer for Mobilize Tucson, and currently works with other organizations like Desert Rising, Good Trouble Action Group, Worker Power, and other Resistance organizations. Prior to the Inauguration, when Bennett set aside most of his other hobbies and activities to fight fascism, he was, and still is, Tucson Project Leader for Matthew 25:34, which is not a church, but a movement for the marginalized, especially focusing on assisting and advocating for our unsheltered neighbors. He is a priest in an independent Catholic denomination and has been in ministry for 30 years, focusing exclusively on marginalized communities of many kinds such as immigrants, refugees, LGBTQ+ folx, at-risk youth, and food-insecure people.

Bennett also had a 31-year career as a corporate executive, more than half of which overlapped with his ministry. He has also acted for many years in local theater (comedy and magic) and film (acting, writing), as an outdoor guide and backpacker, and as an EMT and Director of the Ambulance and Rescue Service for the White Mountain Apache Tribe. To find solace and refreshment of mind, body, and soul these days, Bennett looks to his partner Monica and his dog Lola, as well as the many new friends he has made in Tucson's activist community.
