Monday, February 2, 2026

Tina Whitley: Host

- Welcomed everyone and encouraged them to post something good or hopeful in the Chat.
- Introduced our guest speakers and provided background information on them.

Guest Speaker: Dustin Dame, community volunteer with Tucson Accompaniment Group (TAG)

- TAG is a sister organization with Rapid Response; Susan Gallegos is one of its founders
- TAG observers show up in court every week at asylum and immigration hearings to show their support, bear witness to the proceedings and provide a visual reminder that we care about them.
- Observers take note of the strategies lawyers using; asking “do you want your case dismissed” is a trick question; if they answer yes, they are arrested and sent to detention.
- Volunteers stand outside of court to pass out flyers regarding their rights and resources.
- Anyone can volunteer, being able to speak Spanish is not necessary.
- Most volunteers show up to court between 8:00 and 11:00 am; some opt for afternoon sessions in downtown Tucson; times are flexible, and training involves shadowing an experienced volunteer.
- TAG coordinates with other groups: Salvavision, Defense and Resistance, Keep Tucson Together, Justice for All, along with churches and food banks.

Guest Speaker: Dr. Katie Rose, naturopathic doctor and the founder of GRACE Natural Medicine in Oro Valley

- Dr. Rose works in fertility care and specializes in Emotional Freedom Techniques (EFT) to help reduce stressors and enhance relaxation to get a good night’s sleep.
- Her technique, also known as “Tapping” reduces pain and anxiety and supports a healthy autoimmune system. It can be used with children to help them learn how to regulate their emotions.
- Science shows that tapping on acupressure points while focusing on one’s emotions reduces fear, anger and anxiety.
- Process: 1) name the emotion, where you feel it and rate it from 1 to 10; 2) validate your feeling with “I honor and accept myself” as you move through the pressure points 5 to 7 times, until you are at a 0 to 2 rating and 3) remember to breathe deeply.
- The 9 pressure points: edge of the hand, eyebrow, side of the eye, upper eye, under the nose, chin, collarbone, under arm and top of the head.

- Our first newsletter last Wednesday highlighted the 3 areas our Team is focusing on this session--- Affordability (utilities and the ACC), School Funding/ Vouchers and Voting Rights. We described key legislation affecting all three and recommended actions ITAA members can take.
- We also identified Pima County state legislators and other state officials who sponsored or supported the various bills so that our readers can follow the voting records of their state officials in real time. We must be informed voters when we try to flip the state legislature in the Fall elections.
- We are in the process of lining up speakers for upcoming Membership meetings, including officials addressing voting rights and elections and Democratic candidates for the ACC.
- **2026 legislative proposals to date (as of 2/2/26):** more than 1700 bills introduced; of the 500 from Dems, only 2 were approved by committee.
- **2026 Legislative timeline**
 - **Monday 2/2:** Senate bill introduction deadline
 - **Monday 2/9:** House bill introduction deadline
 - **Friday 2/20:** Last day for a bill to get out of committees in its originating house
 - **Monday 2/23:** Crossover Week begins (most committee hearings are suspended)
 - **Friday 3/27:** Last day for a bill to get out of committees in its crossover house (and the last day to use RTS until a budget drops)
